Participants would learn operational maintenance procedures, such as refueling and recharging. Safety concerns in the workplace would be talked about. Those participating will know the environmental conditions affecting the performance of the lift truck and be able to identify possible hazards. Advanced training on propane handling could be included.

Both employees and employers could face severe penalties if national and industry guidelines are not followed in the operation of forklifts. Employees who operate a reach truck or forklift ought to be well-informed regarding the guidelines concerning their safe operation. Training is recommended for anybody applying for work that needs forklift operation.
