

## Boom Lift License Nanaimo

Boom Lift License Nanaimo - Only completely licensed persons should operate an aerial boom lift. Qualification could be attained through a combination of classroom sessions and practical training with the specific kind of aerial lift that will be utilized on the job. A License is needed for any individual who operates or works on an aerial boom lift.

Vehicle-mounted aerial devices comprise the following work vehicles: aerial ladders, extensible boom platforms, articulating boom platforms, vertical towers, and whatever combination of these types.

When making use of a boom lift, there are several basic safety regulations that apply to all boom lifts. Safety of the worker is a top priority while they are working inside the basket. The worker must at all times wear a body harness and lanyard, connecting it to the basket or boom. Never tie off to an equipment, an adjacent pole or a structure. Personnel must stand on the basket floor, and never sit or climb on the edge of the basket. The load limitations of the manufacturer should be adhered to.

Aerial lift operators must be authorized to make use of the machinery. The operator must know all the aspects of the device and must have access to the manufacturers guidebook that must be kept in the lift. Operators are responsible for making certain that safety procedures are followed in the operation of the lift. A daily test of lift controls should be carried out. Set brakes and position outriggers (if they are used) on a stable surface or on pads. When working on a slope, make use of wheel chocks.

The aerial lift vehicle must never be moved while a worker is within the basket of an elevated boom, unless they are making use of machines which are specifically designed for this. Extensible boom platforms and articulating boom made use of as employees carriers should have plainly marked, accessible, upper controls. Except in emergency circumstances, lower controls should not be utilized to override upper controls unless the individual within the lift gives permission.

While working from an aerial lift, do not wear pole or tree climbers.

The insulated portion of the aerial lift should not be altered.

Make certain that the booms are carefully inspected, that the machinery is properly cradled and the outriggers are in the stowed position before moving.

Make sure that lifts being utilized in or near power lines are di-electrically tested and conform to local regulations.
