Forklift Training Guidelines

The following checklist is essential for any workplace that has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to any question indicates a procedural flaw that can cause accident, injury or damage to equipment.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is access to forklift areas by pedestrians restricted by a barrier?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Are annual checks of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the required tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to use the machine?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any equipment damage and forklift incidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each day?
